SPORTSMANSHIP

Assistant Commissioners Wynns and Walter reported that the Association had received 685 reports of unsportsmanlike conduct during the 2011-12 school year. This figure was similar to last year's figure.

Attorney Robert Baker updated the Executive Committee on the current status of pending litigation against the Association.

PENALTIES ASSESSED

The following penalties were assessed for various violations of the IHSAA By-Laws:

Angola High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 9-18.1 (*Parent and coach used radar gun for scouting purposes*)

1. The Angola High School softball program is issued a warning.
2. The IHSAA accepts, as appropriate, the actions that have been taken to remedy this situation.

Angola High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-2.2 (*Seven softball players were rostered on a non-school sponsored team during the school year out of season*)

1. The Angola High School softball program is issued a warning.
2. Any student athlete involved in this violation that is an underclassman shall be suspended for two Angola High School softball contests during the 2012-13 season.
3. The IHSAA accepts the recommendations of Angola High School as appropriate discipline measures for Head Coach Chris Schuler and Assistant Coach Vern Smith. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable rationale for a rules violation.

Argos High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (*Softball player participated in multiple games without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Argos High School softball program is issued a warning.
2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in a contest at their new school.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, the contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited. Argos is instructed to inform each school involved of this violation.

Avon High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-1.1a (*Boys' golfer participated in a non-school sponsored event during the authorized contest season without an approved waiver*)

1. The Avon High School boys' golf program is issued a warning.
2. The student shall be suspended for next two golf matches on the current Avon High School golf schedule.

Danville High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 9-13 (*Girls' tennis coach conducted a Sunday practice session*)

1. The Danville Community High School girls' tennis program is issued a warning.
2. Coach Vicky Nasteva is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur.
3. The IHSAA accepts the actions taken by Danville Community High School as appropriate disciplinary measures in this matter.

East Chicago Central High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1 (*Three softball players participated while academically ineligible*)

1. The East Chicago Central High School softball program is issued a warning.
2. The student athletes involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition until they meet the minimum standards for academic eligibility.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, East Chicago Central High School shall notify all opponents of this violation and the contests shall be forfeited if East Chicago Central was victorious.

Evansville Mater Dei High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (*Girls' tennis player participated in multiple JV matches without an approved transfer form on file*)

1. The Evansville Mater Dei High School girls' tennis program is issued a warning.
2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in a contest at their new school.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, the scores of the contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be recalculated to reflect the forfeiture of the point played by the ineligible athlete. Evansville Mater Dei is instructed to inform each school involved of this violation.

Evansville Reitz Memorial High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 3-8 (*Baseball player with limited eligibility participated in varsity competition prior to limited eligibility period expiring*)

1. The Evansville Reitz Memorial High School baseball program is issued a warning.
2. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, the contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited. Evansville Reitz Memorial is instructed to inform each school involved of this violation.

Fort Wayne Northrop High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-2.5 (*Several members of football team were receiving instruction from coaching staff during open facility*)

1. The Fort Wayne Northrop High School football program is issued a warning.
2. Coach Tim Martone is reprimanded for causing this violation to occur.
3. The IHSAA supports the reprimands of the football coaching staff by the administration as an appropriate reaction to this violation.

Hebron High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 50-1 (*Two boys' track team members participated in a meet without completing 10 separate days of practice*)

1. The Hebron High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
2. Coach Mike DeFries is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. This violation deals with the health and safety of student athletes and it is absolutely imperative that such rules be enforced to the full extent.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9, the points gained by the ineligible athletes shall be removed and the team score recalculated for this event. Additionally, Hebron High School shall notify all schools involved in this event.

Indiana School For the Deaf – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 4-1 (*Baseball player participate in multiple games while turning 20 years of age on or before the state baseball finals*)

1. The Indiana School for the Deaf baseball program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, Indiana School for the Deaf shall notify all opponents of this violation and any contests where the Indiana School for the Deaf was victorious shall be forfeited.

Indiana School For the Deaf – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 4-1 (*Softball player participate in multiple games while turning 20 years of age on or before the state softball finals*)

1. The Indiana School for the Deaf softball program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, Indiana School for the Deaf shall notify all opponents of this violation and any contests where the Indiana School for the Deaf was victorious shall be forfeited.

North Decatur High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 19-3 (*Softball player participated in multiple games without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The North Decatur High School softball program is issued a warning.
2. It is absolutely mandatory that the "IHSAA Transfer Report" be submitted and acted upon by the Association prior to a student being allowed to participate in a contest at their new school.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, the contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited. North Decatur is instructed to inform each school involved of this violation.

Shelbyville High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 4-1 (*Boys' track runner participated in a meet after turning 20 years of age*)

1. The Shelbyville High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws, Shelbyville High School shall notify Greenfield-Central and New Palestine of this violation. Any points scored in competition by the ineligible athlete shall be vacated and team scores for this event recalculated.

South Bend Riley High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 18-1 (*Girls' tennis player participated in several matches while academically ineligible*)

1. The South Bend Riley High School girls' tennis program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition until she meet the minimum standards for academic eligibility.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws all matches where the ineligible athlete participated shall be forfeited and team scores refigured. South Bend Riley shall notify all schools affected by this ruling.

South Spencer High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 18-1 (*Boys' track athlete participated in two meets while academically ineligible*)

1. The South Spencer High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible for further competition until she meet the minimum standards for academic eligibility.
3. In accordance with Rule 3-9 of the IHSAA By-Laws all points scored by the ineligible athlete shall be removed from the team scores and those scores refigured. South Spencer shall notify all schools affected by this ruling.

Tindley High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Article III, Section 2b (*School is not maintaining a minimum number of sport teams per season per gender – PROBATION*)

1. Tindley High School is placed on probation. Probation is a severe type of warning. If the conditions causing the school's probation are not fully remedied, during the period of probation, a school's membership in the Association may be suspended.
2. Tindley must provide concrete evidence on or before May 8, 2013 that the school has met the minimum requirements of membership. Failure to comply with this request may result in a recommendation of suspension of membership from the IHSAA.

Wawasee High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of 15-1.2a (*Baseball player participated in a non-school sponsored contest without an approved waiver*)

1. The Wawasee High School baseball program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended for four games for violating Rule 15-1.2.
