**MINUTES**

**APPROVE EMERGENCY BY-LAW AMMENDMENT**

**IHSAA By-Law 8-4**

1. Any contestant, coach, Contest Administrator or School Administrator, who is ejected from a Contest for an unsportsmanlike act **the first time during a sport season** shall be suspended for the next Contest at that level of competition and all other Contests at any level in the interim, unless an IHSAA sport-specific rule or policy provides a different protocol or penalty for a first ejection.
2. As an **additional penalty, a coach who is ejected from a Contest the first time during a sport season must successfully complete the NFHS Teaching and Modeling Behavior course before returning coach at a competition, and a contestant who is ejected from a Contest the first time during a sport season must successfully complete the NFHS Sportsmanship course before returning to competition.**
3. Any contestant, coach, Contest Administrator or School Administrator, who is ejected from a Contest for an unsportsmanlike act **a second time during a sport season shall be suspended for the next two (2) Contests at that level of competition and all other Contests at any level in the interim,** unless an IHSAA sport-specific rule or policy provides a different protocol or penalty for a second ejection.
4. These penalties shall be in addition to any other penalties assessed.

A motion to enhance penalties for student athlete, coach, and Contest or School Administrator ejections was made by Nathan Dean; seconded by Geoff Penrod; motion approved 18-0. This amendment to Rule 8-4 is effective immediately.

Brownsburg High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 9-13 (*Football coach conducted an open facility session with two players on a Sunday*).

1. The Brownsburg High School football program is issued a warning.
2. Coach Josh Yoder is reprimanded for this violation.
3. The IHSAA accepts and supports the corrective actions of Brownsburg High School as appropriate measures in this matter.

Cloverdale High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (*Boys' track athlete participated in multiple meets without an approved transfer report on file.*)

1. The Cloverdale High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be rescored after removing the ineligible athlete's scores and the opposing school (s) shall be notified of this violation.

Concord High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1 (*Boys' track athlete participated in multiple meets while academically ineligible*)

1. The Concord High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
2. The interscholastic contests in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be rescored after removing the scores of the ineligible athlete. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Eastern Greene High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 19-3 (*Girls' cross country runner participated in multiple meets without an approved foreign exchange student eligibility request on file*)

1. The Eastern Greene High School girls' cross country program is issued a warning.
2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
3. The contests in which the ineligible athlete participated in shall be rescored after removing the ineligible athlete's scores and the opposing schools shall be notified of this violation.

Evansville Mater Dei High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 18-1 (*Boys' track athlete participated in multiple meets while academically ineligible*)

1. The Evansville Mater Dei High School boys' track and field program is issued a warning.
2. The interscholastic contests in which the ineligible athlete participated shall be rescored after removing the scores of the ineligible athlete. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Hamilton Heights High School – Commissioner Cox reported the following action as a result of a violation of Rule 15-2.2 (*Several members of the boys' basketball team participated together on the same non-school sponsored team*)

1. The Hamilton Heights High School boys' basketball program is issued a warning.
2. Student athletes Jake Beale, Charlie Carter, T.J. Freeland and Nate Roth shall be suspended for two contests on the 2014-15 Hamilton Heights boys' basketball schedule. This penalty may be served over the first four games of the season.
3. Student athletes Sam Beale, Spencer Lybrook and Alex Trachtman shall be suspended for one contest on the 2014-15 Hamilton Heights boys' basketball schedule. This penalty may be served over the first two games of the season.

2. The student athlete involved in this violation shall be suspended and declared ineligible until an approved transfer report is on file.
