IHSAA Football Pairings Show Airs Live Sunday on FOX Sports Indiana

The IHSAA's 2013 football state tournament pairings show will air live Sunday (Oct. 13) at 7 p.m. ET on FOX Sports Indiana, the new television home of IHSAA championships.
